Adult Guests - \$8.00 Senior Guests - \$5.00

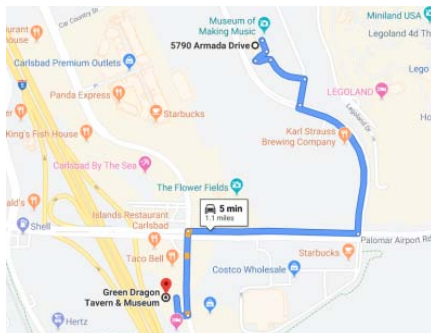
